Key facts / Knowledge:

- The Earth is made up of land and oceans / seas.
- The ocean, coral reef and rock pools are all habitats.
- A habitat is a place where living things live.
- Animals that live in the ocean include sharks, whales, dolphins, crabs, jellyfish, seahorses, string rays and fish.
- A holiday is a fun time with family and friends, especially often spent away from home or travelling.
- Holidays in the past were different to the holidays that people might experience today. 100 years ago, people might take the train to the coast or go to a holiday camp.
- Nowadays, there are different modes of transport, including aeroplanes and fast trains that people can use to travel to different countries.
- A beach is a pebbly or sandy shore by the sea.
- A postcard is like a card that people send to family and friends from their holiday. It is sent by post without an envelope.
- A postcard has a photograph on the front and you write on the back.
- The weather can change throughout the day, week and month. The weather is different at different times in the year. In the Summer, the weather is hot.
- It is important to drink plenty of water to keep hydrated on hot days.
- Wearing sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses can protect the skin and eyes from sun damage.
