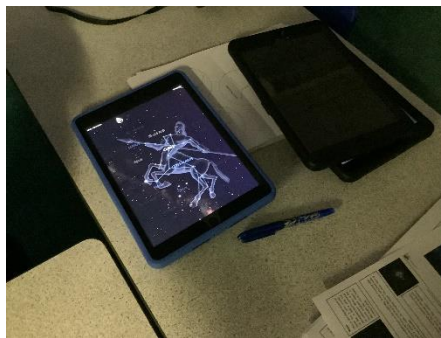

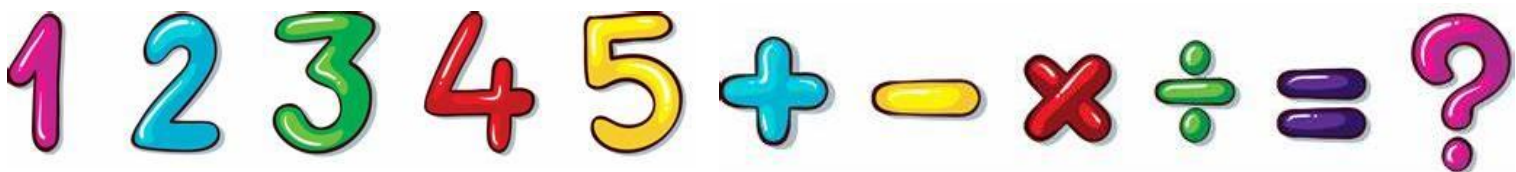


Number Day – Friday 7th February
