We will be learning how to expand noun phrases, use pronouns for clarity and cohesion, use inverted commas for direct speech and use fronted adverbials accurately.</p>		<p><u>In science</u>, we will be working scientifically to find out about sound. We will be investigating pitch and asking relevant questions.</p>		<p>As <u>mathematicians</u>, we will be developing our understanding of fractions and decimals as well as extending our knowledge of multiplication tables.</p>	
<p><u>In RE</u>, we will explore our key question: 'What do we mean by truth? Is seeing believing?'</p>	<p><u>In French</u>, will be continuing to learn about animals.
