We will read <i>Escape from Pompei</i> by Christina Balit in our English lessons. We will be using this as inspiration to write a historical narrative.		As <b>scientists</b> , we will be working scientifically to find out about the digestive system, teeth and food chains.	As <b>mathematicians</b> , we will be developing our multiplication and division skills. We will also complete a topic on length and perimeter.
As <b>readers</b> , we will focus on retrieval and inference skills when comprehending texts.	In <b>computing</b> lessons, we will learn about data and information, including data logging. <b>Online Safety</b> - our topic will be online reputation.	As <b>designers</b> , we will be designing and creating simple pencil cases using our sewing skills.	As <b>geographers</b> , we will be studying mountains and volcanoes. We will be learning about the earth's structure and how mountains and volcanoes are formed.
As <b>musicians</b> , we will be listening to music from the past and using this as inspiration to compose our own.	In PE lessons, we will complete units on gymnastics and handball.	In RE, our big question will be: What do we mean by truth?	In <b>French</b> , will be learning: As tu un animal?
			In <b>Learning for Life</b> lessons, we will explore families and healthy relationships. We will continue to explore Zones of regulation.
