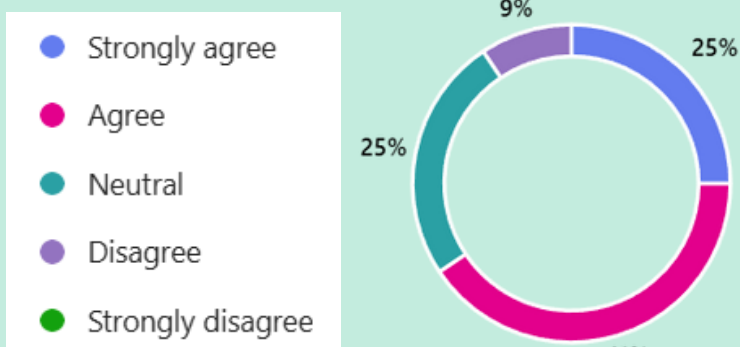

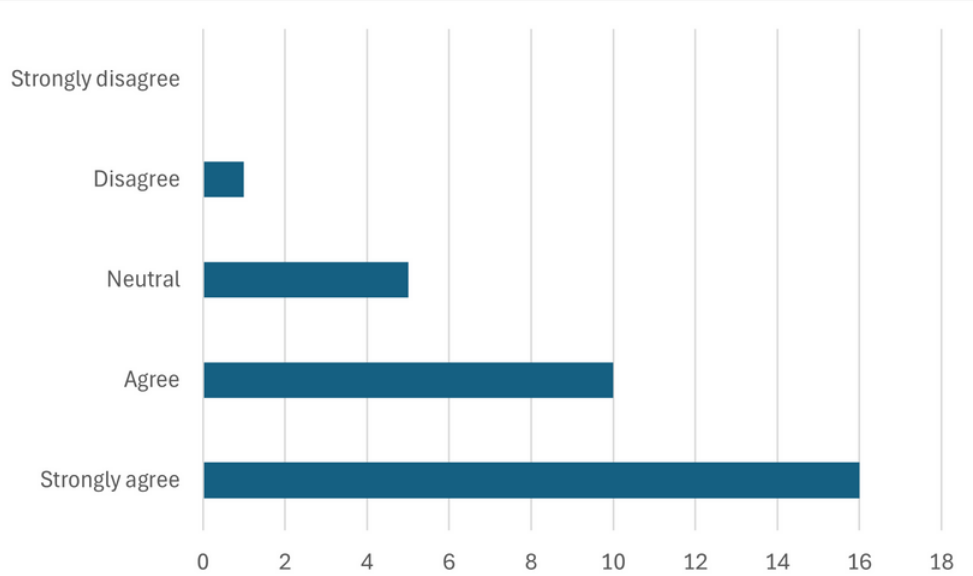
1 My child feels happy and safe at school

91% of parents either strongly agreed, agreed or were neutral.

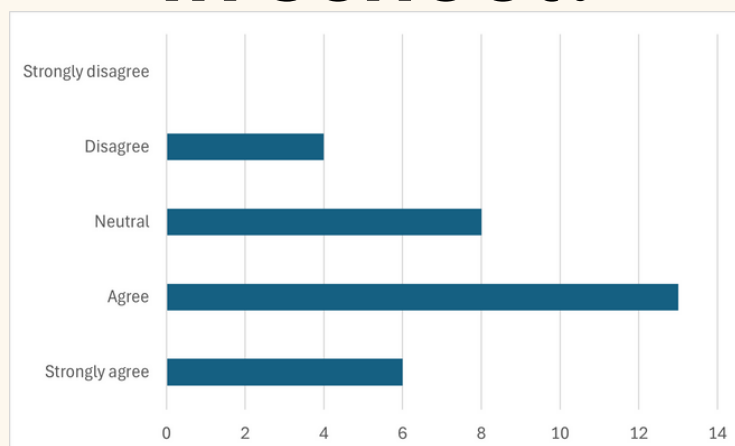


4 I am able to approach staff about concerns that I have regarding my child.

2 Do you feel your child and their needs are supported in school?

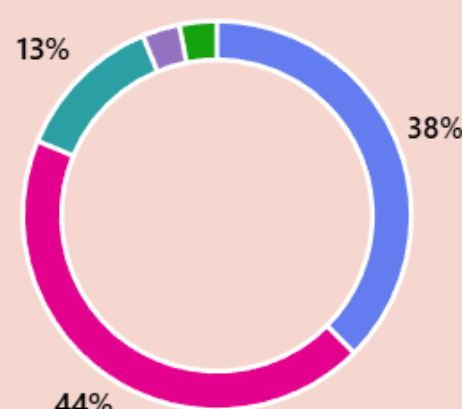

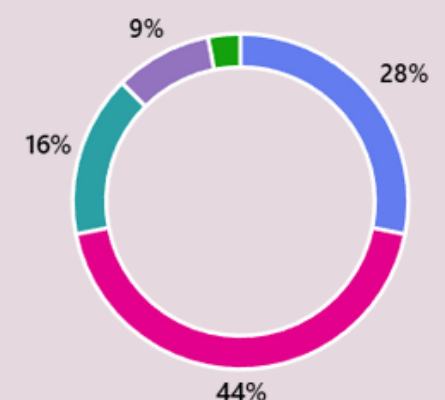
5 I have confidence in the leadership of SEND provision within the school.

95% of parents either strongly agreed, agreed or were neutral.

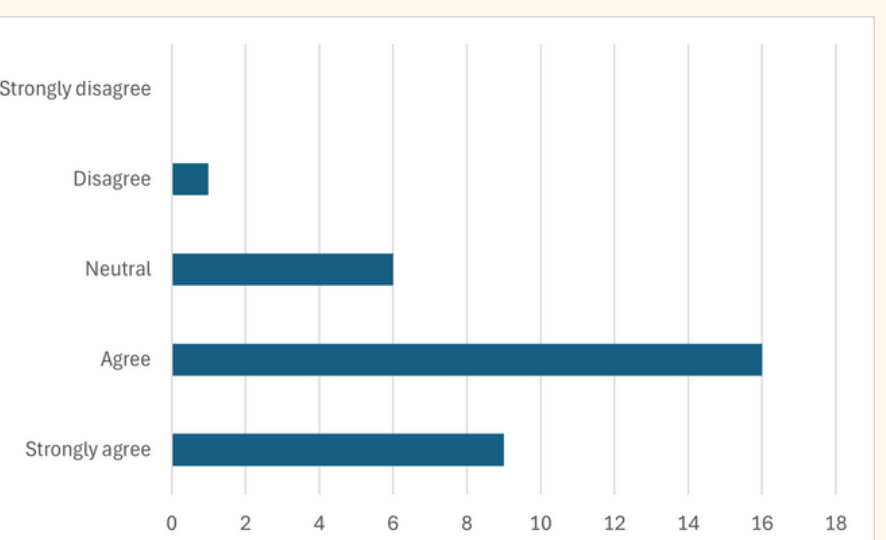


3 I am aware of my child's Holistic Action Plan and One Page Profile

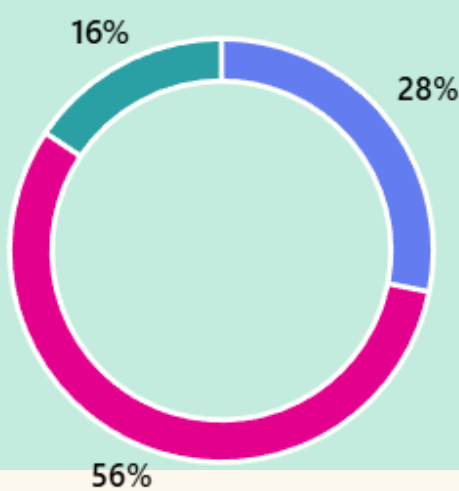

My child feels like they have someone to talk to if they need to e.g. class teacher, TA or member of the Senior Leadership Team.

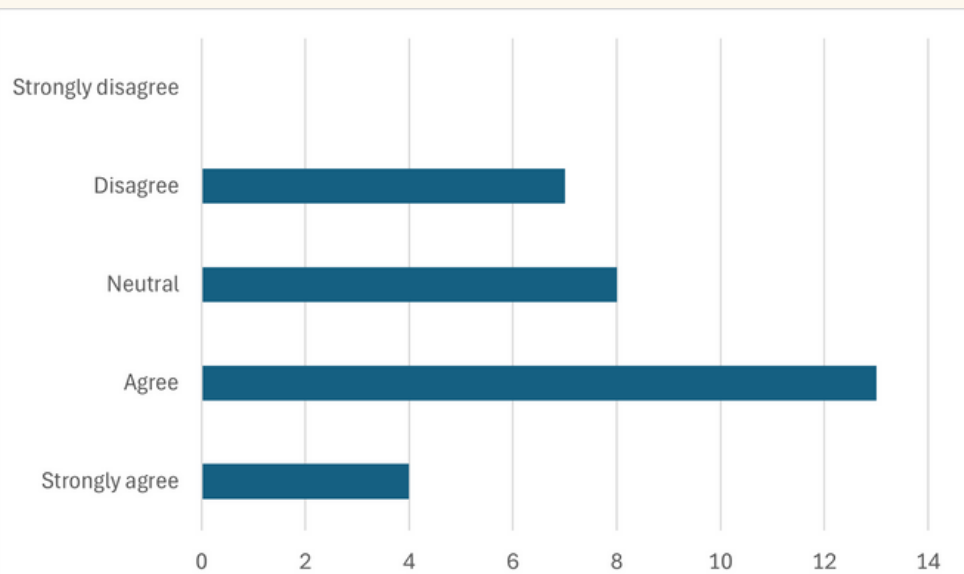

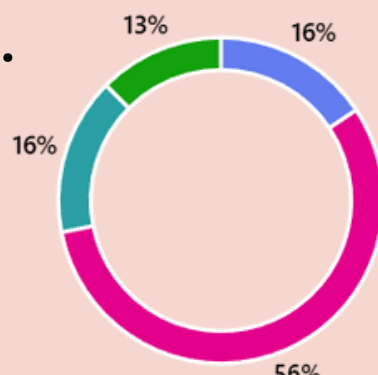

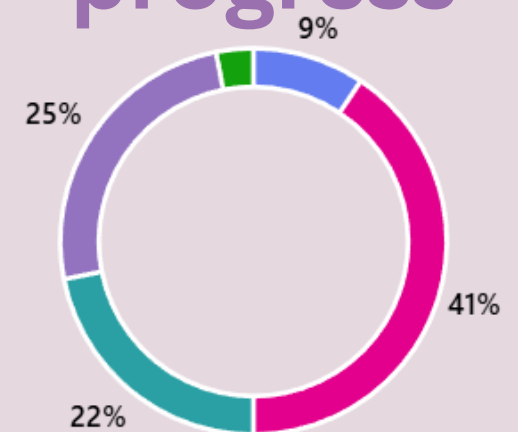
The school supports my child with social, emotional and mental health difficulties.
