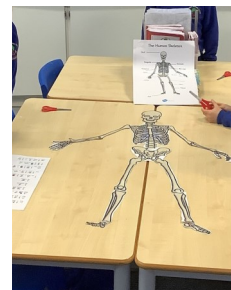
Year 2 enjoyed a walk around the village today to explore the different things they could expect to find in a village.

## Right To Choose Pathway

We have been made aware that there has been a slight change to process for families seeking to access the Right to Choose pathway. If your child is registered at the Mulbarton doctor's surgery, they have added information to their website here: [ADHD and Autism Referrals - The Humbleyard Practice](#).

There are two pathways to refer into: Neurodevelopmental Services who can receive referrals from the school. Please note there is currently a 6+ year waiting list for this assessment. The other route is a Right to Choose referral. This can only be completed by a GP following the steps listed in the link above.
