New appointments

We are delighted to let you know that we have successfully appointed two teachers to join us next year. One teacher will be in Year 3 and one will be working alongside Mrs Bird in Penguins class in Year 5. They will be in school next week for our transition days, where they will spend time with their new classes. There will be an opportunity for you to pop in and meet them too (see below).

Transition Days

We will be holding our transition days on **Thursday 10th and Friday 11th July**. These days provide an excellent opportunity for the children to meet the children in their class and the adults who will be working with them in September and begin to form new relationships. They will be working in their new classrooms so will begin to familiarise themselves with their new surroundings. Teachers will have begun talking to the children about this exciting change ahead and will be preparing the children so they know what will be happening on these two days.

On both days, we would like the children to arrive at school in the usual way through their usual gate. They will go to their current classroom to start the day. The children will not move to their new

classroom until after registration. They will return to their current classroom for the end of the day. This is to avoid any additional anxiety and possible confusion about where to go.

Reception children who will be working in the year 1 base will go into lunch at 11.45am.

If your child is currently in Y4, they will not have their usual enrichment activities on Thursday 10th. They will stay with their new teacher all day. If your child is currently in Y3, they will have an additional enrichment afternoon. They will have a PE lesson with Mrs Bidder and an Outdoor Learning lesson with Ms Laniardo. For Outdoor Learning, the children will just need a waterproof. The children will need to wear their PE kit on Thursday.

We would also like to invite you to meet your child's new teacher after school on Thursday 10th July. Please collect your child at 3.15pm from their usual classroom. Your child will then walk with you around the outside of school to their new classroom. You are invited to pop in to say hello to the adults who will be working with your child in September, and you are welcome to have a look at the classroom too.

We are all looking forward to an exciting end to next week as we begin to look ahead to September.
