We have lots of amazing news to share with you this week.

End of Key Stage 2:

Our KS 2 SATS results were published this week. We are delighted to announce we have exceeded national outcomes in all subject areas. The children have worked exceptionally hard all year; their attitude to learning has been commendable and we couldn't have asked more of them. They are ready to start the next stage of their education at high school.

(Percentages relate to number of children achieving the expected standard.)

Reading: 83%

Writing: 75%

Maths: 76%

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG): 78%

Science: 84%

You will receive a breakdown of your child's results alongside their school report.

EYFS outcomes: 75% of children in Reception class have achieved GLD (Good Level of Development). This is above last year's national outcome.

Phonics screen Y1: 85% This is above last year's national outcome of 80%.

Phonics screen re-takes Y2: 73% of the children who re-took their phonics screen this year passed.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check: 22% achieved full marks this year, with 56% achieving between 20-25 marks. This is a significant improvement from last year.

Thank you to all of the children for continuing to work hard and always try their best in all that they do. Thank you to the teachers for their commitment to always ensure the very best outcome for all of our children.
